Terms of Reference (ToR) for the Tamu (Gurung) Culture Forum-UK Editorial Board:

The Executive Board of the Tamu Culture Forum-UK, hereinafter referred to as ‘Tamu Forum Executive Board’ has constituted an Editorial Board and appointed Dr Tek Lem Tamu as the ‘Editor-in-Chief’ to lead the Editorial Board and Edit the final draft manuscript of the Tamu Heritage Trilingual Book (तमू (गुरुङ) सम्पदा “त्री-भाषीय पुस्तक” गुरुङहरूको इतिहास, संस्कृति, भाषा र सभ्यता), hereinafter referred to as the ‘Tamu Heritage Book’.

The final draft manuscript is a compilation of write-up initiated in 2014 by members of the Executive Board, experts and Advisors of Tamu Forum. The compilation also involved fact-checking of the draft manuscript by the Patron of Tamu Forum, Pragya Dr. Jagman Khrongi-Lam Tamu. These write-ups are based on the research work of individual writers backed up by archaeological studies undertaken by Cambridge University & Pachyu Paingdi Chiba (PPC) Yarjung Tamu's team. The write-ups are further informed by a number of studies and intensive research work carried out by Dr. Jagman Tamu & other Tamu researchers and scholars on Tamu culture and traditions (रीतिथिती), that were established by our ancestors and eventually passed on to the next generations. These culture and traditions (रीतिथिती) were developed for the collective benefit of the Tamu (Gurung) community and is our common heritage.

The main responsibility of the Editorial Board will be to edit the final draft manuscript of the Tamu Heritage Book into a version understandable to a broad range of readership and format it to a publishable form. The process can include removing filler materials, check for grammatical/spelling/punctuation errors, further fact-check, and improve, simplify and maintain a consistent tone of written words for better readership. The team will also develop a style-guide for a consistent and professional presentation of the book. In developing the style-guide and editing the manuscript, the Editorial Board will work closely with the respective authors and the Tamu Forum Executive Board.

Specific Responsibilities of the Editorial Board include the following:

- 1) Develop a style-guide for the chapters and a structural outline of the Tamu Heritage Book in close consultation with the Tamu Forum Executive Board.
- 2) Removing irrelevant and repetitive texts and re-writing some of the content: The Editorial Board is responsible for removing irrelevant texts from the draft Tamu Heritage Book. This may require eliminating filler and repetitive materials. The Editorial Board may also be required to rewrite some of the content for a more structured presentation of the information and a more simplified language to help the readers better understand the intended message. While eliminating the

irrelevant content(s), the Editorial Board will consult the respective authors through the Tamu Forum Executive Board and convey the reason behind the decision to the author. The Editorial Board will also develop a comparison report of the original and the edited manuscript to help the authors understand the changes.

- 3) Performing line editing for grammatical / spelling / vocabulary / punctuation errors, style and vocabulary usage. This will also include simplifying the sentences for better communication.
- 4) Fact checking: The Editorial Board will run a fact-check of the contents in the book. If deemed essential, in consultation with the Tamu Forum Executive Board and the respective author(s), the Editorial Board may need to conduct minor secondary research work to confirm the accuracy of the information.
- 5) The Editorial Board will compile a bibliography for the Tamu Heritage Book following a standard citation style. Respective authors will be consulted in developing the bibliography and citation will be included as and where needed.
- 6) While initiating the editing work, the Editorial Board will develop and agree to a timeline with the Tamu Forum Executive Board to achieve the tasks outlined in the ToR latest by the end of May 2024.
- 7) In delivering to its responsibilities, the Editorial Board will work closely with the Tamu Forum Executive Board and keep them informed of the work progress. All communication with the authors will be through the Tamu Forum Executive Board.
